PRE-TRIP & POST-TRIP: Safety is the most important and obvious reason to inspect your vehicle. A vehicle defect found during an inspection could save you problems later. You could have a breakdown on the road that will cost time or even worse, an accident. Federal and state laws require pre and post-trip inspections by the driver. If you fail to do a pre-trip inspection, a DOT inspector can place your vehicle out of service. So why risk your life or the life of another in an unsafe vehicle? Without inspections, lives can be lost. Skipped or sloppy inspections add to the risk of a mechanical failure and out-of-service time. Proper procedures for conducting a pre and post-trip inspection can be found in your Safety Manual, Section 19, Pg. 85.
