END OF SCHOOL YEAR: Please remember to prepare your vehicles for the summer lay-up period. Return vans immediately after your last school is completed.

If your van has a sign for a camp, you must return the vehicle immediately so it may be prepped for camp delivery. We have a limited amount of time to prep vans for camps this year with school ending on Friday, 6/24. Any other arrangements must be made with Maureen Salerno at the Moffitt Center. All Pond Road vans are to be returned to Pond Road unless otherwise directed by Maureen. Bay Shore vans are to be returned to Row G or E unless it is designated as a camp van. All camp vans must be returned to the main yard at Bay Shore (10 Moffitt Blvd). When returning your van, please make sure the following is done:

1. Vans should have full tank of fuel - turn car seats into the Shop
2. The route sign is taken out of the plastic holder; DO NOT remove the holder
3. Do not remove the "P" Permit card in the back window of the van
4. All windows closed and cleaned including the driver's window. Clean and sweep out the inside of your bus.

PLEASE DO NOT SWEEP GARBAGE INTO THE PARKING LOTS. If available, please run your bus through the bus wash.
