CDL PERMIT CLASS: Our CDL Permit Class is a great opportunity for our DAs, our families, and friends to learn more about our great Company. Our next CDL permit class will be held on Wednesday, July 31, from 10:00AM-1:00 PM at **1780 Smithtown Ave, Ronkonkoma**. This class is free, and everyone is welcome. Remember, for a limited time we offer a \$1,000 bounty for every driver referral and you will receive the referral bonus 60 days after they are assigned a school bus route. This is effective through September 30, 2024. DA's who receive their

CDL permit by July 31, 2024, can receive a \$1,000 bonus. Bonus to be paid out when assigned to a van route.

SUNGLASS SAFETY: The eyes are susceptible to being burned by sunrays. The cornea, lens and retina are all vulnerable to overexposure of ultraviolet (UV) rays. Over time, these UV rays—invisible to the human eye—can harm the eye if left unprotected. Sunglasses help in two important ways. They filter light and protect the eyes from damaging UV rays. Long-term exposure to UV rays can lead to cataracts, macular degeneration or skin cancer around the eyelids. Sunglasses should be worn outdoors to protect your eyes.
