<u>YARD SAFETY</u>: Our yards are active with buses, personal vehicles, and employees. Yard speed is always **under** 10 MPH whether traveling in a bus or car. Please use the proper entrance and exit gates and stay in the appropriate travel lanes. Employees are to wear Company jackets with the reflective strips so you can be seen. Remember:

- Keep alert when walking in the yard; do not have your head down.
- Always utilize crosswalks where applicable.
- Refrain from talking and texting on your cell phone in the yards.
- Park in marked spots only. Do not block vehicles or double-park in the yard or outside the gates. Your vehicle blocks the view for other drivers to safely navigate.
- Use the correct driver assistant pick-up areas in your yard and not on public roadways.
- Driver assistants look both ways when exiting your bus in the yard.

<u>ACCIDENT AWARENESS</u>: Now that school is back in full swing, please refresh your mindset back to your training. Remind yourself to stay vigilant for any and all obstructions that can occur. We cannot assume everyone pays attention to their environment. We as professional drivers and driver assistants should be extra aware of our surroundings. Use extra precaution at intersections, watching out for pedestrians and oncoming traffic. Be mindful of stationary objects including parked vehicles and basketball hoops. If your vehicle appears too big to pass down a tight street, stop and navigate safely. Think of the bus as your personal vehicle...would you try to pass in a tight area with your car?
