To enable this, confirm that your email and mobile number are correct under "My Profile." "My Profile" can be accessed through your Dayforce home page by clicking on the upper right-hand, circular, icon that displays your initials. If needed, click "edit" to update them. Additionally, scroll to the bottom of the page and select "Update Security Questions" to set up recovery questions for identity verification. By taking these steps you help mitigate the risk of an account lockout.
